Operating Guideline # 214

Loose Equipment in Apparatus Cab

September 28, 2019



PURPOSE:

The purpose of this Operating Guideline (OG) is to increase the safety of firefighters during emergency response.

ISSUE/RATIONALE:

Loose equipment inside the cabs of fire apparatus poses a severe risk to firefighters should the apparatus become involved in a collision or rollover.

GUIDELINE:

- 1. All firefighting equipment that may become a projectile and potentially injure firefighters in the event of a crash (flashlights, hand tools etc.) shall not be stored in the apparatus cab unless fastened in a mounting mechanism that can withstand the forces of a 9G rollover. Equipment that cannot be properly mounted shall be stored in the apparatus compartments.
- 2. Equipment stored in vehicle cabs shall remain fastened in their stored position until the apparatus has come to a complete stop.
- 3. All latching mechanisms will be inspected at the earliest opportunity when equipment has been removed to ensure the latching feature is working properly.

RESPONSIBILITY:

It is the responsibility of all staff to comply with the provisions of this Operating Guideline.
